1948 - Israel became a nation – May 14, 1948 A.D. {2} Iyar 5, 5708 C.E. [rd. 0]

Arab nations declare war on Israel

Second series of wars began between arab nations and Israel

1966 [7th seven] Rosh Hoshana – Sept. 15, 1966 A.D. -- {7} Tishri 1, 5727 C.E. [rd. 6698]

1967 - 50th year - 6 day war – June 5 – 10, 1967 – Israel gains control of Jerusalem

1973 [8th seven] Yom Kippur War Oct. 6 – 25. 1973

4th Blood Moon – Sept. 28, 2015 A.D. – {7} Tishri 15, 5776 C.E. [rd. 24608]

only Blood Moon visible in both Israel and U.S. [Israel around 4:47 a.m.; U.S. around 9:47 p.m.]

2022 [15th seven] Rosh Hoshana – Sept. 26, 2022 A.D. -- {7} Tishri 1, 5783 C.E. [rd. 27163]

2029 [16th seven] Rosh Hoshana – Sept. 10, 2029 A.D. -- {7} Tishri 1, 5790 C.E. [rd. 29704]

2036 [17th seven] Rosh Hoshana – Sept. 22, 2036 A.D. -- {7} Tishri 1, 5797 C.E. [rd. 32273]

2043 [18th seven] Rosh Hoshana – Oct. 5, 2043 A.D. -- {7} Tishri 1, 5804 C.E. [rd. 34842]

2050 [19th seven] Rosh Hoshana – Sept. 17, 2050 A.D. -- {7} Tishri 1, 5811 C.E. [rd.37381]

Note: Jubilee Years not recognized by Jews since Babylonian captivity [All twelve tribes must be in Israel.]

Biblically Jubilee is year after 49th year {seven-sevens} - Jewish years divisible by 7 [5775/7 = 825] are

Sabbatical Years, Each of the above years 1924 [5685], 1931 [5692], ... 2015 [5776] etc. begin a new 7 year

period – the year before each of them 1923 [5684], 1930 [5691] ... 2014 [5775] etc., end a 7 year sequence

Years of Jubilee according to Leviticus 25 are commemorated by the blowing of the ram’s horn on the Day of

Atonement [{7} Tishri 10] in the 49th year. [rd.] – Reference date computed from May 14, 1948 A.D. Iyar 5,
